## HealthCare Institute of New Jersey statement on first list of medicines subject to government price setting

Trenton, August 29, 2023 — Dean J. Paranicas, President and Chief Executive Officer of the HealthCare Institute of New Jersey (HINJ – <a href="www.hinj.org">www.hinj.org</a>), released the following statement concerning the Administration's announcement of the first ten prescription medicines subject to government price setting:

"We remain firmly committed to working with policymakers on finding ways to lower health care costs for patients, but not by jeopardizing future treatments and cures for disease states like Alzheimer's, HIV/AIDS, diabetes, rare diseases, cancer and other life-threatening illnesses. Government price controls decimate the innovation ecosystem that continues advancing global human health and which, most recently, discovered a cure for hepatitis C, vaccines against cervical cancer, the first-ever treatment for Alzheimer's, and vaccines and treatments against new threats such as COVID-19. We will continue working with all stakeholders — including patient groups desperately awaiting the discovery of new treatments and cures — on policies that protect both the patient community and medical innovation."
